### Gospel Reflection:

Today's Gospel passage is part of Jesus' talk on the end time, when the world as we know it will end and God's Kingdom will come completely. Jesus tells a parable that urges people to be aware of what God has asked them to do in their life and be ready for the arrival of God's Kingdom. The theme of this parable is that the wise are prepared to complete their task. The multiplication of the talents can be seen as an increase in good works performed in the name of Christ Jesus.
